

Leaves and Trees Nature Walk (Pearson Math Makes Sense Unit One - Patterns)

Take a walk with your students and collect as many different kinds and colours of leaves that you can find.

When you get back to the classroom:



Kindergarten

- * Have kindergarten students extend repeating patterns (two or three elements) with the leaves by playing the "What's Hiding?" game with the leaves in lesson four in unit one of the Math Makes Sense program.
- * Use the leaves for lesson five in unit one of the Math Makes Sense program.

Grade One

- * Have grade one students do the "Copy Patterns" activity with the leaves in lesson one in unit one of the Math Makes Sense program.
- * Have grade one students translate the repeating leaf patterns to another representation. Use the leaves for lesson four in unit one of the Math Makes Sense program.



Grade Two

- * Have grade two students do the "Hot Potato" activity with the leaves in lesson one in unit one of the Math Makes Sense program.
- * After lesson six in unit one, have the students work on the unit centre "Making Patterns in Different Ways" from the Math Makes Sense program.
